The South African Reserve Bank (the Bank) wishes to implement/mature Business Intelligence (BI) throughout the Bank. The services of companies specialising in business intelligence (including the provision of BI resources), will be required from time-to-time. The Bank wishes to establish a preferred supplier list for these services and interested parties are invited to respond in order to be considered for future tenders. The Bank's Business Intelligence technologies are based on the Oracle and Microsoft platforms.

Interested parties are invited to express their interest by furnishing the following documentation to the Bank:

- Your Company Profile;
- Comprehensive information relating to the BI services rendered by your company
- CVs of BI resources in your employment or that can be made available to the Bank on a full-time basis;
- Valid broad-based black economic empowerment (BBBEE) rating certificate;
- Valid tax clearance certificate.

Your expression of interest must be an original printed document accompanied by one hardcopy copy and an electronic copy (PDF), clearly marked "**original**" and "**copy**". Please quote the heading and reference number at the top of this document, as well as the closing date and time. The documents must be enclosed in a sealed envelope. Applications will be received until **11:00 on Friday, 28 November 2014**. Your expression of interest should be deposited in the **tender box** at the South African Reserve Bank, **370 Helen Joseph Street, Pretoria**.

The Bank reserves the right to rescind this process, should it deem necessary to do so. However, all respondents will be informed accordingly. Failure to accede to any instruction contained in this document will lead to disqualification. Late submissions will not be considered.
