Adjusting to the fall in oil prices: the recent Colombian experience

Biographical details/achievements

José Darío Uribe E has been the Governor of the Banco de la República (Banco Central de Colombia) since January 2005. Prior to that, he had worked as the Deputy Governor of the central bank, starting in January 1998, and as the Director of the bank's Research Department from September 1993 to December 1997. Before joining the central bank, he was a Unit Director for the National Planning Department and Economic Adviser for the National Federation of Coffee Growers. He has taught macroeconomics and economic growth at various universities in Colombia since 1993. He has bachelor degrees in Business Administration from EAFIT University (1981) and Economics from Los Andes

University (1984), and earned a doctorate (PhD) in Economics at the University of Illinois at Urbana–Champaign (1993). He has authored several articles published in national and international journals on monetary policy, exchange rates and economic growth. Dr Uribe has also been an editor and member of the Editorial Committee of Academic Journals (*Revistas Académicas*), and has received awards for his academic accomplishments in Colombia and his work as the head of a central bank on an international level.
