New designs. Correct Afrikaans word "Sjielings" adopted. In the case of the Ten Shilling and One Pound notes, Afrikaans and English predominated alternately with each series of one million forms. In the case of Five Pound note, Afrikaans predominated on the first half of each series and English on the second half.
