3. **Coverage**
Where all the subsidiary organisations of the main organisation are operating in the same sector of economic activity, consolidated information for groups of organisations should be reported on Form F02. Organisations engaged in a sector of economic activity other than that of the main organisation should submit separate returns.
4. **Nil returns**
This form should be returned to the South African Reserve Bank even in those cases where it contains no information.
5. **Duplicate of return**
A copy of this return should be retained for reference purposes.
