Notice on the 'Publication of a supplement containing revised national accounts statistics as well as a discussion of the conceptual, methodological, classification and source data changes'

On 25 August 2021 Statistics South Africa (Stats SA) published the revised benchmarked estimates of gross domestic product (GDP) for the period from the first quarter of 1993 to the fourth quarter of 2020. This was followed by the release on 7 September 2021 of revised GDP numbers for the first and second quarters of 2021.

Owing to the close proximity of the release of the September 2021 *Quarterly Bulletin* to the Stats SA releases, the South African Reserve Bank (SARB) required more time to provide a comprehensive set of historical tables. Since then, selected historical statistics were published on the SARB website on 21 October 2021 and 15 December 2021. A supplement containing all the revised national accounts statistics from 1946 as well as a discussion of the conceptual, methodological, classification and source data changes will be published by the SARB on 22 February 2022. Note that the supplement contains minor revisions to certain time series published on 15 December 2021.
