Following the March 2022 announcement by the SARB Governor on 'the rotation of the SARB Deputy Governors and appointment of Prudential Authority CEO', Fundi Tshazibana officially started as the DG and CEO of the PA with effect from 1 April 2022.

#### Loss absorbency – A resolution prevention tool

South Africa has been working on strengthening its resolution framework, which requires systemically important financial institutions to hold sufficient levels of loss-absorbing instruments enabling recapitalised without the need for an injection of public funds. In the event of a resolution, this form of recapitalisation would be achieved by way of a bail-in, allowing the SARB, as the Resolution Authority, to impose losses on the shareholders and certain creditors.

#### IFRS 17 Assessment Report

In June 2021, The Prudential Authority issued a survey to insurers supervised by the Banking, Insurance, Co-operative Financial Institutions and Financial Market Infrastructure Supervision Department of the PA as part of the flavour-of-the-year topic engagements on International Financial Reporting Standard 17: Insurance Contracts (IFRS 17). The survey questions were aimed at gaining insights into the progress and state of the implementation of IFRS 17 for these insurers.
