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A statistical presentation of South Africa's balance of payments for the period 1946 to 1970

It is accepted practice to revise quarterly and annual balance of payments statistics regularly once a year for the preceding year or two in order to incorporate information which became available after the first estimates had been published. However, owing to periodic major changes in concepts and definitions and the continuous improvement of basic information, it is also essential to revise balance of payments statistics every decade or two. As indicated in the December 1970 Issue of the Quarterly Bulletin, South Africa's balance of payments figures were revised completely during the course of 1970 and these data were already published in the above-mentioned issue of the Bulletin. In order to obtain comparability over time and to facilitate economic research, annual balance of payments figures from 1946 to 1970 and quarterly and monthly data from 1960 to 1970 are published in Tables 1 to 11 of this Supplement.

A brief description is given below of the specific changes in concepts and definitions, the implications of the change in the territorial coverage to exclude Botswana, Lesotho and Swaziland from the figures referring to South Africa's domestic territory and the main improvements of the basic statistics.

Changes in concepts and definitions

In revising South Africa's balance of payments, the compilation of figures was brought in line with standard international principles as laid down in the United Nations' A System of National Accounts¹ and the International Monetary Fund's Balance of Payments Manual². The concept gold and foreign exchange reserves was revised to agree with standard international practice, while the definition of monetary banking institutions as defined by the Reserve Bank from 1965 was also applied to years prior to 1965.

No. 2, Rev. 2, New York, 1964, will be referred to as the former SNA.

(a) Gold and foreign exchange reserves

Although the Manual does not provide a standard definition of gold and foreign exchange reserves, the International Monetary Fund's monthly publication International Financial Statistics contains a standardised presentation in which the so-called reserve position of a country in the International Monetary Fund is, inter alia, included in the gold and foreign exchange reserves. The reserve position in the Fund (also called the net IMF position) is defined as the sum of a member's gold tranche position (i.e. ordinary and super gold tranches)3 and outstanding lendings to the Fund. The treatment in the balance of payments statistics of accounts with the Fund varies considerably from country to country. In South Africa only the super gold tranche position³ was formerly included in the exchange holdings. However, drawings on the Fund that do not raise the Fund's holdings of the member's currency beyond an amount equal to the member's quota are generally also granted automatically. One of the more important amendments to the Articles of Agreement of the International Monetary Fund which were agreed to by the member countries during 1969, eliminated the Fund's legal power to challenge a request by a member country for a drawing on the Fund within its gold tranche position. Both the gold and super gold tranche positions of a country in the Fund therefore now represent foreign exchange which is readily available to the country. Similarly, outstanding lendings to the Fund are repayable when the lending country itself experiences a balance of payments deficit or when a member repurchases its currency from the Fund. As South Africa has not entered into any loan agreements with the Fund, only the gold and super gold tranche positions in the Fund are relevant and have been included as

³A country's gold tranche position is equal to the quota of the country in the IMF minus the Fund's holdings of its currency, if the amount is positive. Normally, it will represent that part of the country's quota, namely 25 per cent, which must be paid in gold. Should the IMF hold less than 75 per cent of a country's quota risc currency, the gold tranche position will be greater than its gold subscription. The excess is sometimes referred to as a *super* gold tranche position in the IMF.

part of South Africa's gold and foreign exchange reserves in the revised balance of payments figures.

In Tables 10 and 11, where the foreign liabilities and assets of South Africa are shown for the period 1956 to 1969, the gold and super gold tranche positions in the International Monetary Fund have not been included in the short-term assets of the central government and banking sector. In the compilation of these two tables the foreign liabilities and assets of South Africa were recorded on a gross basis, i.e. assets and liabilities were not offset against each other. South Africa's quota in the Fund is, therefore, shown in these tables as a long-term asset of the central government and banking sector, while the holdings of South Africa's currency by the Fund are included under the short-term liabilities of this sector.

In Table 9, where the gold and foreign exchange reserves of South Africa are shown, a separate column was included to indicate the total holdings of Special Drawing Rights, i.e. original allocations plus designations.

(b) Taxes on investment income

Investment income was formerly entered in South Africa's balance of payments before deduction of taxes paid by or on behalf of the recipients to the authorities of the country in which the investment income had been earned. This principle was applied to all forms of investment income. According to the International Monetary Fund's Manual, taxes on earnings of branches and other unincorporated direct investment enterprises, and taxes on earnings of corporate direct investment enterprises before distribution, should, however, be considered payable by these organisations and not by their foreign owners. These types of investment income should therefore be entered in the balance of payments net of the income taxes paid to the authorities of the country in which the organisations operate. In agreement with this principle, branch and partnership profits, profits from farming and other unincorporated enterprises and income distributed by corporate direct investment enterprises, are now entered in the revised balance of payments after taxation paid by these enterprises.

(c) Migrants' effects

In accordance with earlier editions of the Manual, migrants' personal and household effects were formerly included in the South African balance of payments under merchandise exports or imports and private transfer payments or receipts. The Manual now stipulates, however, that exports or imports of migrants' personal and household effects should not be included in the balance of payments because these transfers are not included in the imports of the country of immigration or the exports of the country of emigration in the national accounts. Accordingly, the published export and import figures of the

Department of Customs and Excise, which include migrants' personal and household effects, are now adjusted to exclude these data, and migrants' effects are also not taken into account in the determination of private transfer payments or receipts.

(d) Monetary banking sector

The balance of payments figures were also revised for the period 1946 to March 1965 to incorporate the definition of the monetary banking sector as used from 1965 by the Reserve Bank for purposes of monetary analyses. Formerly, the foreign capital flows of the central government and banking sector were restricted in the case of the banking sector to those of the Reserve Bank, commercial banks, the National Finance Corporation and discount houses. From March 1965 the banking sector was redefined to include also the merchant banks and other banking institutions of which the monthly average amount of demand deposit liabilities during the preceding calendar year amounted to at least R1 000 000 (R3 000 000 as from January 1971) and of which the monthly average amount of short and mediumterm deposit liabilities during the preceding year collectively amounted to at least one-third of the total deposit liabilities of such an institution or at least R30 000 000. In the revised figures the foreign capital flows of registered banking institutions are now included under the central government and banking sector and excluded from the private sector as from the date that these institutions conformed with the requirements of the above definition. The gold and foreign exchange reserves were also revised for the period prior to March 1965 to include the exchange holdings of institutions complying with the definition of a monetary banking institution.

(e) Fixed investment of extra-territorial bodies

In the former SNA, the fixed capital outlays of extraterritorial bodies of foreign governments and international agencies on the construction of buildings and other immovable assets for civilian use were regarded as part of fixed investment of the country where the construction actually took place, while in the new SNA they are regarded as part of fixed investment of the foreign government, i.e. the owner of the assets. The construction of buildings and other immovable assets by the South African government in the domestic territory of foreign countries is therefore now regarded as part of South Africa's fixed investment and is included in merchandise imports, while the construction of buildings and other immovable assets by foreign governments and international agencies in South Africa is considered as part of merchandise exports and not as part of the fixed investment of South Africa. This revision also implies that the imputed rent on such assets, which was formerly included under factor payments or receipts from or to the rest of the world, is now con-

sidered to be a transaction between domestic residents and consequently does not affect the balance of payments.

(f) Grants of military supplies and equipment

In the former SNA, grants of military supplies by one government to another were excluded from the merchandise exports of the donor country and merchandise imports of the receiving country, while they are now included in the trade statistics in conformity with the recommendations of the new SNA. These transactions are now also included under the transfer payments or receipts of the government to or from the rest of the world as contra entries.

The exclusion of Botswana, Lesotho and **Swaziland**

The Reserve Bank's Quarterly Bulletin up to the September 1970 issue contained balance of payments figures representing consolidated data relating to the Republic of South Africa, South West Africa, Botswana, Lesotho and Swaziland⁴. The need has long been felt to deconsolidate the balance of payments figures for the Customs Union so that only balance of payments data reflecting transactions between a domestic territory, consisting of the Republic and South West Africa, and the rest of the world, now also including Botswana, Lesotho and Swaziland⁵. Consequently the revised and deconsolidated figures in Tables 1 to 11 refer to the domestic territory of South Africa comprising the Republic and South West Africa only.

The existence of a Customs Union between the BLS-countries and South Africa and the fact that the Rand is used as a common currency made the exclusion of the balance of payments figures of the BLS-countries from those of South Africa particularly difficult. Customs figures of exports and imports and analyses of foreign exchange transactions, which are basic sources of information for the compilation of balance of payments data, refer to the Customs Union and Rand Currency Area and do not include transactions between members. In order to obtain balance of payments figures for South Africa only, the transactions of the BLS-countries with the rest of the world must be deducted from the figures for the Customs Union, while transactions between residents of the BLS-countries and residents of South Africa must be added. Data obtained from statistical bodies in the BLS-countries were consolidated to eliminate transactions between BLS-countries mutually and with non-Customs Union countries which do not concern the South African balance of payments.

The transformation of the current account of the balance of payments of the Customs Union into

figures referring to South Africa only involved a large number of adjustments based on various sources of statistical information. The adjustment of merchandise imports and exports was of particular importance and owing to a lack of other data was mainly based on the foreign trade statistics collected by the BLS-countries. For balance of payments purposes the official BLStrade statistics were furthermore adjusted to provide for under coverage and for valuation free on rail or truck at the border of the exporting country. In the case of exports timing adjustments were also made to obtain calendar year figures.

Another important adjustment to the current account of the balance of payments concerned the large number of migrant labourers from the BLScountries in South Africa. Estimates were made of their earnings and expenditure in South Africa based on the average remuneration of Bantu workers employed by the mining and other industrial sectors and the cash remittances of mine workers to their country of origin.

As far as international transfers are concerned, the governments of the BLS-countries receive large foreign aid payments from the United Kingdom and this necessitated considerable adjustments to government transfer receipts.

In the compilation of the balance of payments all information concerning the capital account is collected directly by the Reserve Bank from individual organisations and persons. Data of the capital transactions between residents of the BLS-countries and the rest of the world were collected separately during the past and could therefore be excluded from the figures of the Customs Union. The financial transactions of the residents of the BLS countries with South Africa were obtained from annual and quarterly sample surveys conducted by the Reserve Bank on foreign capital movements.

Improvement of statistical data

In revising South Africa's balance of payments, it was endeavoured to improve the reliability of the various components as far as possible by the use of additional statistical information which became available. Tourist expenditure and receipts for example were improved on the basis of unpublished quarterly information obtained from the Department of Statistics, while quarterly information was also obtained from the South African Airways in connection with their freight and other transportation receipts and expenditure. The quarterly and annual sample surveys conducted by the Reserve Bank on foreign transactions, liabilities and assets, which in particular are used to determine net investment income and net capital movements of the private sector, were also extended considerably to improve the coverage. Estimates of the expenditure of foreign Bantu workers in South Africa now also cover the foreign workers employed in industrial sectors and not only that of mining as previously.

These countries are referred to as the Customs Union, Referred to collectively as the BLS-countries, Referred to as South Africa.

'n Statistiese aanbieding van die betalingsbalans van Suid-Afrika vir die tydperk 1946 tot 1970

Dit is aanvaarde gebruik dat kwartaallikse en jaarlikse betalingsbalansstatistiek gereeld een keer per jaar vir die voorafgaande jaar of twee hersien word, sodat inligting wat beskikbaar gekom het nadat die eerste ramings gepubliseer is, bygewerk kan word. As gevolg van belangrike periodieke veranderings in begrippe en definisies en die voortdurende verbetering in basiese inligting, is dit egter ook noodsaaklik om die betalingsbalansstatistiek elke dekade of twee te hersien. Soos in die Desember 1970-uitgawe van die Kwartaalblad aangedui, is Suid-Afrika se betalingsbalansgegewens in sy geheel gedurende 1970 hersien en hierdie inligting is reeds in bogemelde uitgawe van die Kwartaalblad gepubliseer. Ten einde vergelykbaarheid oor tyd te verkry en om ekonomiese navorsing te vergemaklik, word jaarlikse betalingsbalanssyfers vanaf 1946 tot 1970 en kwartaallikse en maandelikse gegewens vanaf 1960 tot 1970 in tabelle 1 tot 11 van hierdie bylaag gepubliseer.

'n Kort beskrywing van spesifieke veranderings in begrippe en definisies, die implikasies van die verandering in gebiedsdekking om Botswana, Lesotho en Swaziland van die inligting wat op die Suid-Afrikaanse huishoudelike gebied betrekking het uit te sluit en van die belangrikste verbeterings in die basiese statistiek word hieronder gegee.

Veranderings aan begrippe en definisies

In die hersiening van die Suid-Afrikaanse betalingsbalans, is die berekening van syfers in ooreenstem ming gebring met standaard internasionale beginsels soos voorgeskryf in die Verenigde Volke Organisasie se A System of National Accounts1 en die Balance of Payments Manual van die Internasionale Monetêre

Fonds. Die begrip goud- en buitelandse valutareserwes is hersien om ooreen te stem met die standaard internasionale praktyk, terwyl die definisie van monetêre bankinstellings, soos dit sedert 1965 deur die Reserwebank gedefinieer word, ook op die jare voor 1965 toegepas is.

(a) Goud- en buitelandse valutareserwes

Alhoewel die handleiding nie 'n standaard definisie van goud- en buitelandse valutareserwes voorsien nie, bevat die Internasionale Monetêre Fonds se maandelikse publikasie, International Financial Statistics 'n gestandaardiseerde aanbieding waarin die sogenaamde reserweposisie van 'n land in die Internasionale Monetêre Fonds, onder andere, by die goud- en buitelandse valutareserwes ingesluit word. Die reserweposisie in die Fonds (ook genoem die netto IMF-posisie) word gedefinieer as die som van 'n lidland se goudtranche-posisie (d.w.s. die gewone en super goudtranches)³ en uitstaande lenings aan die Fonds. Die hantering van rekeninge met die Fonds in betalingsbalansstatistiek varieer aansienlik van land tot land. In die geval van Suid-Afrika is slegs die super goudtranche-posisie³ vroeër by die valutareserwes ingesluit. Trekkings op die Fonds wat nie die Fonds se besit aan valuta van 'n lidland bo die bedrag gelyk aan 'n lidland se kwota verhoog nie, word egter ook normaalweg outomaties toegestaan.

Een van die meer belangrike wysigings in die Akte van Ooreenkoms van die Internasionale Monetêre Fonds waartoe lidlande gedurende 1969 ingestem het, skakel die Fonds se wetlike mag uit om 'n versoek van 'n lidland vir 'n trekking op die Fonds binne sy goudtranche posisie te betwis. Beide die goud- en die super goudtranche-posisies van 'n land

Normaalweg verteenwoordig dit daardie gedeelte van die land se kwota, 25 persent, wat in goud betaal moet word. Indien die Fonds dus minder as 75 persent van 'n land se kwota in sy valuta besit, sal die goudtranche-posisie groter wees as sy goudbydrae. Die oorskot word soms na verwys as die super goudtranche posisie in die

in die Fonds verteenwoordig gevolglik buitelandse valuta wat geredelik tot sy beskikking is. Insgelyks is uitstaande lenings aan die Fonds ook terugbetaalbaar wanneer die land self 'n betalingsbalanstekort ondervind of wanneer 'n lidland sy valuta van die Fonds terugkoop. Aangesien Suid-Afrika tot nog toe nie enige leningsooieenkomste met die Fonds aangegaan het nie is slegs die goud- en die super goudtrancheposisies in die Fonds ter sprake en is dit ingesluit as deel van Suid-Afrika se goud- en buitelandse valutareserwes in die hersiene betalingsbalanssyfers.

In tabelle 10 en 11 waar die buitelandse laste en bates van Suid-Afrika vir die tydperk 1956 tot 1969 getoon word, is die goud- en super goudtrancheposisies in die Internasionale Monetêre Fonds nie ingesluit in die korttermyn bates van die sentrale regering en banksektor nie. In die opstelling van hierdie twee tabelle is die buitelandse laste en bates van Suid-Afrika op 'n bruto basis aangeteken d.w.s. bates en laste is nie teen mekaar afgesit nie. Suid-Afrika se kwota in die Fonds is gevolglik in hierdie tabelle as 'n langtermyn bate van die sentrale regering en banksektor getoon terwyl die besit van Suid-Afrika se valuta deur die Fonds onder korttermyn laste van hierdie sektor ingesluit is.

In tabel 9 waar die goud- en buitelandse valutareserwes van Suid-Afrika aangetoon word, is 'n afsonderlike kolom ingesluit wat die totale besit aan Spesiale Trekkingsregte aandui, d.w.s. oorspronklike toewysings plus verdere aanwysings om Trekkingsregte te neem.

(b) Belastings op beleggingsinkome

Beleggingsinkome is vroeër in Suid-Afrika se betalingsbalans ingesluit voor aftrekking van belastings betaal deur of namens die ontvanger, aan die owerhede van die land waar die beleggingsinkome verdien is. Hierdie beginsel was van toepassing op alle vorme van beleggingsinkome. Volgens die handleiding van die Internasionale Monetêre Fonds, moet belastings op verdienstes van takke en ander nie-geinkorporeerde direkte beleggingsondernemings, en belastings op verdienste voor verdeling van geïnkorporeerde direkte beleggingsondernemings egter beskou word as betaalbaar deur hierdie organisasies en nie deur hulle buitelandse eienaars nie. Hierdie tipes van beleggingsinkome moet derhalwe in die betalingsbalans opgeneem word netto van die inkomstebelasting betaal aan die owerhede van die land waarin die ondernemings opereer. In ooreenstemming met hierdie beginsel word tak- en vennootskapwinste, boerderywinste en ander nie-geïnkorporeerde ondernemings, en inkome uitgekeer deur geïnkorporeerde direkte beleggingsondernemings in die hersiene betalingsbalans opgeneem nadat belastings deur hierdie ondernemings betaal is.

(c) Besittings van migrante

In ooreenstemming met vroeër uitgawes van die

handleiding, is migrante se persoonlike en huishoudelike besittings vroeër in die Suid-Afrikaanse betalingsbalans ingesluit onder goedere-uitvoer of -invoer en private oordragbetalings of -ontvangste. Die handleiding bepaal nou egter dat die uitvoer of die invoer van migrante se persoonlike en huishoudelike besittings nie in die betalingsbalans ingesluit moet word nie, omdat hierdie oordragte nie in die nasionale rekeninge onder die invoer van die land van immigrasie of die uitvoer van die land van emigrasie ingesluit word nie. Gevolglik word die gepubliseerde uitvoer- en invoersyfers van die Departement van Doeane en Aksyns wat migrante se persoonlike en huishoudelike besittings insluit, nou aangepas om hierdie gegewens uit te sluit, en migrante se besittings word ook nie in berekening gebring by die bepaling van private oordragbetalings of -ontvangstes nie.

(d) Monetêre banksektor

Die betalingsbalansstatistiek is ook vir die tydperk 1946 tot Maart 1965 hersien om ooreen te stem met die definisie van die monetêre banksektor soos dit vanaf 1965 deur die Reserwebank vir doeleindes van die monetêre ontleding gebruik word. Vroeër is die buitelandse kapitaalvloeiinge van die sentrale regering en banksektor, in die geval van die banksektor beperk tot die vloeiinge van die Reserwebank, die handelsbanke, die Nasionale Finansiekorporasie en die diskontohuise. Vanaf Maart 1965 is die banksektor herdefinieer om voorsiening te maak vir die însluiting van aksepbanke en ander bankinstellings waarvan die gemiddelde maandelikse bedrag aan onmiddellik opeisbare deposito-verpligtings gedurende die voorafgaande kalenderjaar minstens R1 000 000 (R3 000 000 vanaf Januarie 1971) bedra het, en waarvan die maandelikse gemiddelde bedrag aan kort- en middeltermyn deposito-verpligtings gedurende die voorafgaande kalenderjaar gesamentlik of minstens een-derde van so 'n instelling se totale deposito-verpligtings of minstens R30 000 000 bedra het. In die hersiene syfers word die kapitaalvloeiinge van geregistreerde bankinstellings nou onder die sentrale regering en banksektor ingesluit en uitgesluit by die privaatsektor vanaf die datum waarop hierdie instellings aan die vereistes van bogenoemde definisie voldoen het. Die goud- en buitelandse valutareserwes is ook vir die periode voor Maart 1965 hersien om voorsiening te maak vir die insluiting van die valutabesit van instellings wat aan die definisie van 'n monetêre bankinstelling voldoen.

(e) Vaste investering van nie-inwoner liggame

In die vorige SNA is vaste kapitaalbesteding deur nie-inwoner liggame van buitelandse regerings en internasionale agentskappe aan die oprigting van geboue en ander onroerende bates vir burgerlike doeleindes, as deel van vaste investering van die land

waar die oprigting werklik plaasgevind het, beskou. In die nuwe SNA word dit egter as deel van die vaste investering van die buitelandse regering, d.w.s. die eienaar van die bates, beskou. Die oprigting van geboue en ander onroerende bates deur die Suid-Afrikaanse regering in die huishoudelike gebied van vreemde lande, word dus nou ook as deel van Suid-Afrika se vaste investering beskou en gevolglik ingesluit in goedere-invoer, terwyl die oprigting van geboue en ander onroerende bates deur vreemde regerings en internasionale agentskappe in Suid-Afrika as deel van goedere-uitvoer, en dus nie as deel van Suid-Afrika se vaste investering nie, beskou word. Hierdie hersiening impliseer dus ook dat toegerekende huur op sulke bates, wat voorheen onder faktorbetalings aan of faktorontvangste van die res van die wêreld ingesluit is, nou as 'n transaksie tussen binnelandse inwoners beskou word en gevolglik nie die betalingsbalans beïnvloed nie.

(f) Skenkings van militêre voorrade en toerusting
In die vorige SNA is die skenking van militêre
voorrade deur een regering aan 'n ander uitgesluit by
die goedere-uitvoer van die skenker en die goedereinvoer van die ontvanger terwyl dit nou in ooreenstemming met die aanbevelings van die nuwe SNA
by die handelstatistiek ingesluit word. Hierdie transaksies is nou ook ingesluit onder regeringsoordragbetalings aan of -ontvangste van die res van die
wêreld as kontra-inskrywings.

Die uitsluiting van Botswana, Lesotho en Swaziland

Die Reserwebank se Kwartaalblad tot en met die September 1970-uitgawe bevat betalingsbalanssyfers wat gekonsolideerde gegewens met betrekking tot die Republiek van Suid-Afrika, Suidwes-Afrika, Botswana, Lesotho en Swaziland⁴ verteenwoordig. Die behoefte bestaan reeds lank om die betalingsbalanssyfers vir die Doeane-unie te dekonsolideer sodat slegs betalingsbalanssyfers wat betrekking het op transaksies tussen die huishoudelike gebied, wat uit die Republiek en Suidwes-Afrika bestaan, en die res van die wêreld wat voortaan ook Botswana. Lesotho en Swaziland⁶ insluit, weerspieël word. Gevolglik het die hersiene en gedekonsolideerde gegewens in tabelle 1 tot 11 slegs op die huishoudelike gebied" van Suid-Afrika, wat uit die Republiek en Suidwes-Afrika bestaan, betrekking.

Die bestaan van 'n Doeane-unie tussen die BLSlande en Suid-Afrika en die feit dat die Rand as 'n gemeenskaplike geldeenheid gebruik word, het die uitsluiting van die BLS-lande van die betalingsbalanssyfers van dié van Suid-Afrika aansienlik bemoeilik.

Doeane-syfers van invoer en uitvoer en die ontleding van buitelandse valutatransaksies, wat basiese bronne van inligting vir die opstelling van die betalingsbalans is, verwys na die Doeane-unie en die Randgeldeenheidgebied en sluit nie transaksies tussen lede in nie. Ten einde betalingsbalanssyfers vir Suid-Afrika alleen te verkry, moet die transaksies van die BLS-lande met die res van die wêreld afgetrek word van die syfers vir die Doeane-unie, terwyl transaksies tussen inwoners van die BLS-lande en inwoners van Suid-Afrika bygetel moet word. Statistiese inligting verkry van liggame in die BLS-lande is gekonsolideer ten einde transaksies tussen BLSlande onderling en met nie-Doeane-unie lande wat nie die Suid-Afrikaanse betalingsbalans raak nie, uit te skakel.

Die omskakeling van die lopende rekening van die betalingsbalans m.b.t. die Doeane-unie tot syfers wat slegs op Suid-Afrika betrekking het, het 'n groot aantal aansuiwerings gebaseer op verskeie bronne van statistiese inligting, behels. Die aansuiwering van goedere-invoer en -uitvoer was van besondere belang en a.g.v. die gebrek aan ander gegewens, is dit hoofsaaklik gebaseer op buitelandse handelstatistiek deur die BLS-lande versamel. Vir betalingsbalansdoeleindes is die amptelike BLS-handelstatistiek verder aangesuiwer om voorsiening te maak vir onderdekking en vir waardasies vry op spoor of pad op die grens van die uitvoerland. In die geval van uitvoer is tydaanpassings ook gemaak om kalenderjaarsyfers te verkry.

'n Ander belangrike aansuiwering aan die lopende rekening van die betalingsbalans het betrekking op die groot aantal trek-arbeiders uit die BLS-lande in Suid-Afrika. Ramings is van hulle verdienstes en besteding in Suid-Afrika gemaak gebaseer op die gemiddelde vergoeding van Bantoewerkers werksaam in die mynbou- en ander nywerheidsektore, asook kontantoorplasings van mynwerkers na hulle land van herkoms.

Wat internasionale oordragte betref, ontvang die regerings van die BLS-lande groot buitelandse bystandbetalings van die Verenigde Koninkryk en dit het aansienlike aansuiwerings aan regeringsoordragontvangste genoodsaak.

In die opstelling van die betalingsbalans, word alle inligting met betrekking tot die kapitaalrekening direk deur die Reserwebank van indiwiduele organisasies en persone ingesamel. Besonderhede van kapitaaltransaksies tussen inwoners van die BLS-lande en die res van die wêreld is in die verlede afsonderlik ingesamel en kon dus geredelik uitgesluit word uit die syfers van die Doeane-unie. Die finansiële transaksies van inwoners van die BLS-lande met Suid-Afrika is verkry uit die jaarlikse en kwartaallikse steekproefopnames van buitelandse kapitaalbewegings wat deur die Suid-Afrikaanse Reserwebank opgeneem word.

Verbetering van statistiese gegewens

Met die hersiening van Suid-Afrika se betalingsbalans is gepoog om die betroubaarheid van die verskillende komponente sover as moontlik te verhoog deur gebruik te maak van bykomende statistiese inligting wat beskikbaar gekom het. Toeriste-uitgawes en -ontvangstes is byvoorbeeld verbeter deur van ongepubliseerde kwartaalgegewens, van die Departement van Statistiek verkry, gebruik te maak terwyl kwartaalsyfers ook van die Suid-Afrikaanse Lugdiens in verband met hulle vrag- en ander vervoerontvangstes en -uitgawes, verkry is. Die kwartaallikse en jaarlikse steekproefopnames van die Reserwebank oor buitelandse transaksies, laste en bates wat in besonder gebruik word om die betalingsbalansposte oor netto beleggingsinkome en netto kapitaalbewegings van die private sektor te raam, is ook aansienlik uitgebrei ten einde die dekking te verbeter. Ramings van die uitgawes van buitelandse Bantoewerkers in Suid-Afrika dek nou ook buitelandse werknemers werksaam in die nywerheidsektor en nie slegs in die mynbou soos voorheen nie.
