Chartered Accountant Trainee Programme

The three-year Chartered Accountant (CA) Trainee Programme aims to address the shortage of CAs in the Bank and in the country. Trainees are given an opportunity to acquire the prescribed competencies of the South African Institute of Chartered Accountants, reinforce their academic education, develop business acumen, and learn life skills and professional and ethical values. Trainees are placed on rotation in the various departments and subsidiaries of the Bank, thus obtaining practical experience and a good overview of the business of central banking.

To be considered, candidates must:

- have a Certificate in the Theory of Accounting (CTA) or be in the process of completing it;
- be a South African citizen; and
- be a curious and innovative individual.

Successful candidates work at the Bank's Head Office in Pretoria from January to December of that year.
