

PA to coordinate, collaborate and engage with relevant external stakeholders




Processes and systems that will allow for more efficient co-ordination and collaboration on supervision and oversight

Umoja Implementation approach

The PA is moving away from the use of secure email functionality to send applications and notifications

Phase 1

Supervised Institution Management (Aug 23)

- 1. Access the portal on a secure domain
- 2. Submit applications/ notifications
- 3. Manage the supervised institution profile information
- 4. Interact with the Prudential Authority in a convenient manner.

Phase 2

Submission Management & standard reporting (Jul 25)

1. Enable institutions to submit regulatory returns via the portal.

Phase 3

Risk Management & Reporting

 The Umoja solution will automatically calculate the risk rating of each institution.

Standardised process for handling Licensing Applications

Automated approach to the management and visualisation of demand and work-related tasks in the context of case management.

Reporting and Analytics dashboards in relation to profile and case management.



Benefits

- Industry
 - Institutions are now accountable for the accuracy of their profile data.
 - Institutions will be able to track the status of submissions on the portal.
 - Communication through the portal through two-way comments
 - Automated pro-forma invoice
- PA
 - Enhanced teamwork and collaboration
 - The PA will only be responsible for the approval of the information based on the outcome of the case.
 - Improved data quality
 - Standadised communication to the Industry
 - Automated application fees, invoice and receipts






Baseline versus Target Architecture




How the data was transported before/after?


